**Kata Tjuta (The OLGAS)
represents Shri Parvati**

Also worshiped as Shri Ganesh Gauri by Sahaja Yogis. We worship Her Holiness Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi in the form of Mother Parvati, holy consort of Lord Shiva and mother of Shri Ganesh.



ULURU ALSO KNOWN AS AYERS ROCK

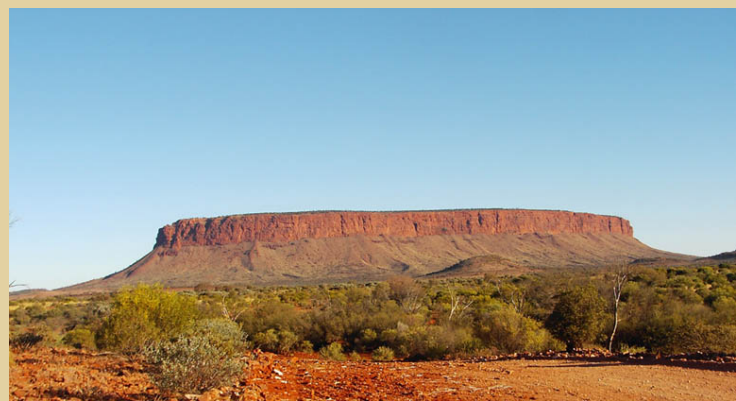
Uluru represent Shri Ganesh



AYERS ROCK/ ULLURU

A Swayambhu

The world famous monolith known as Uluru is located in the southwestern corner of **Australia's Northern Territory**. Uluru is sacred to the Pitjantjatjara Anangu, the Aboriginal people of the area. It's also known as Ayers Rock.



MOUNT CONNER

**Also known as Attila/ Artilla
Represents Shri Shiva**

We worship Her Holiness Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi in the form of Lord Shiva. Mount Conner is the swayambhu that represent Lord Shiva - the embodiment of pure spirit. In our Subtle system, Lord Shiva and Mother Parvati occupy the Left Heart.

THE 3 SWAYAMBHUS

Uluru, Kata Tjuta, Mount Conner

Uluru represents Shri Ganesh. 20 kms to its west is Kata Tjuta (The OLGAS) represents Shri Parvati, and 60 kms its east is Attila (Mount Conner, a private land) represents Shri Shiva.

These three Swayambhus form a straight line and represent the Mother, father and the son.
